

# **Mrs. Scott's 5/6 Class Supply List**

*NOTICE: The things under "Student Items" will be used in class on a regular basis. Parents may choose to buy some or all of these items. Anything their child does not have on this list will be furnished by the school.*

## **Student items (for personal use):**

- container for items below (pencil box OR *large* zipper pouch)
- 2 highlighters (different colors)
- 2 blue or black pens
- 2 red pens
- 1 pack post-its/sticky notes, (about 3"x3" in size)
- 24-pack colored pencils (nothing bigger than a 24-pack please)
- Ticonderoga pencils
- water bottle - to be left at school, (please send water bottles that are well-balanced, that will not tip easily)
- 2 dark-colored dry erase markers (blue, black, green, brown, purple, etc.; FYI - red & pink do not erase very well) - 5th grade only
- Simple function calculator - 6th grade only

## **Optional student items:**

- plug-in headphones
- computer mouse
- combination lock for locker (keys with locks tend to get lost)
- 1 white or pink, rectangular eraser (if you think your child will use it)
- handheld, NO-battery pencil sharpener

## **Class-Use donation items:**

- Kleenexes
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 1 pkg Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 pkg Lined paper
- Regular Expo Markers
- Fine-tipped black Expo Markers
- packs of post-its/sticky notes
- black sharpie markers
- whiteboard erasers
