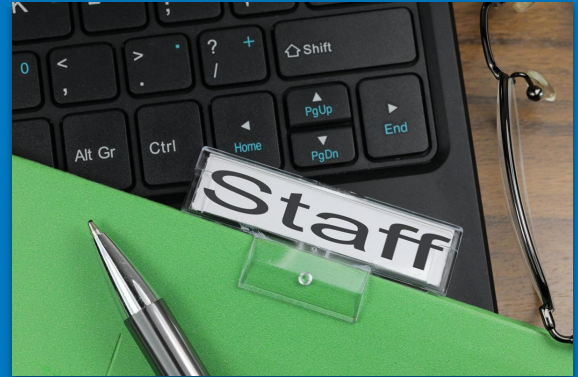


Director's Report

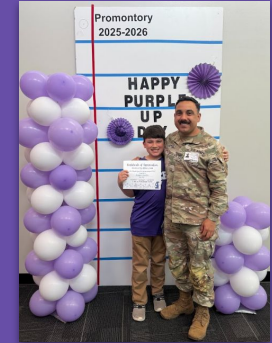
Public Relations

Our online community continues to grow!

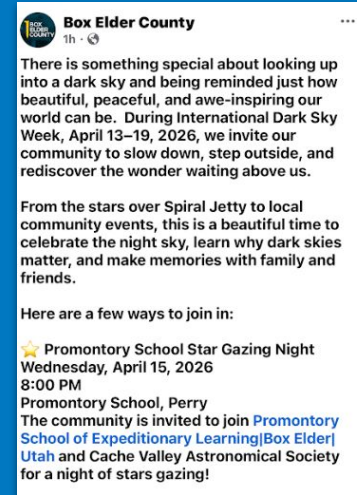
We are excited to share some strong recent social media momentum:

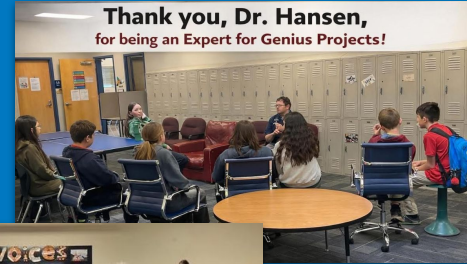

Instructional Updates

- State RISE testing starts next week
- Teachers are preparing for end-of-year Intensives, and developing expeditions for next school year
- School Improvement Efforts
 - With staff, we will begin referring to our School Improvement Plan as our “School Work Plan” (an EL term), to support an intentional focus on strengthening core practices and emphasizing our Expeditionary Learning model
 - Admin has been reviewing our essential core practices from this year
 - Planning a PD on April 24th to establish our essential core practices for next year
 - Admin is working on all the compliance requirements with the state for school improvement that are due this school year
- Mega Celebration
 - Each community will host its own Celebration of Learning this spring. In place of a Mega Celebration, we'll come together on May 15th for a school-wide Movie in the Park and fundraiser. Stay tuned for details!
