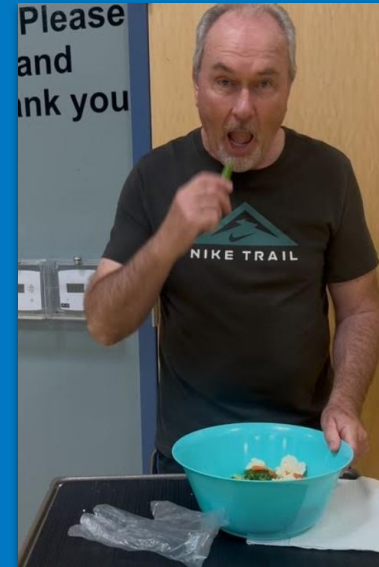

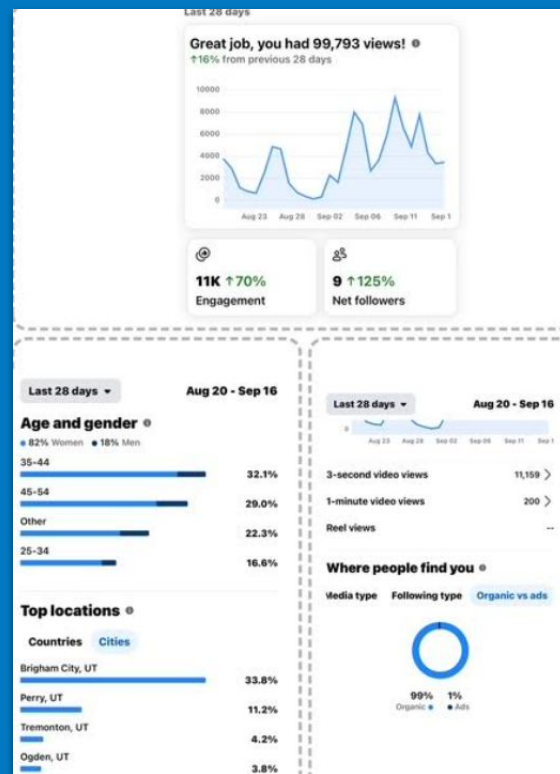

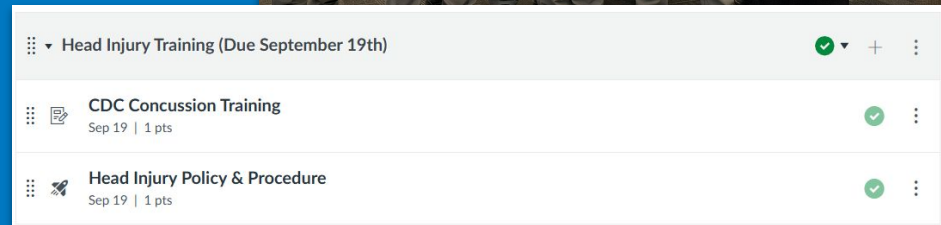

- Janni working with Dr. Reina on math scope & sequence

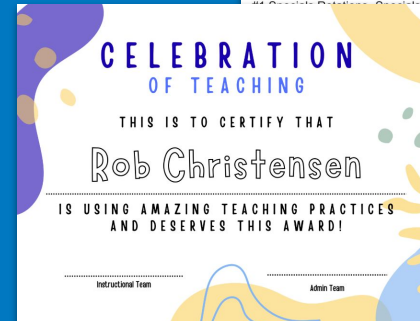
Instruction
