



ANNUAL HEALTH SCREENING NOTICE

VISION SCREENING

Utah law requires public schools to conduct annual vision screenings for students in the following grades:

- Kindergarten
- 1st
- 3rd
- 5th
- 7th

Vision screenings help identify potential vision concerns that may affect learning and school performance. These screenings are brief and are not a replacement for a comprehensive eye exam by an eye care professional.

Vision screenings at Promontory will take place during the first two weeks of the school year.

HEARING SCREENING

Utah law requires public schools to conduct routine hearing screenings for school-aged students in accordance with state guidelines.

Hearing screenings help identify potential hearing concerns that may affect learning and school performance. These screenings are brief and are not a replacement for a comprehensive hearing evaluation by a licensed audiologist.

OPT-OUT OPTION:

Vision and hearing screenings are required by state law; however, parents may choose to opt out. To decline either or both screenings, a parent or guardian must provide the school office with a written statement indicating which screening(s) they do not want their child to participate in. This statement must be submitted to the school office prior to the screening and must be completed each school year.
